Preaching and Teaching

- Primary preacher for Heartland Community Church

- Provide leadership and mentorship to those teaching youth programs
- Proclamation of God's Word, centered in Jesus Christ, should be the main focus
- Strong biblical and expository preaching skills
- Deliver sermons in an interesting, creative, and motivating manner

Introduction:

Heartland Community Church is a small church that is laid back and mostly contemporary. We are unique in that we love and support one another to learn and grow in our love for the Lord through using our gifts in different ministries.

History:

Currently we are renting the auditorium of the Saint Charles Elementary school and a few rooms to use for junior church and adult bible study on Sunday. We also rent an office space in the education building of the Methodist church. This is where the Pastor's office is and where youth group is currently meeting. In recent years, because of a fervent desire to see growth, both spirituality and numerically within the church, we have a desire to hold worship in our own facility. We own property and have a committee that is seeking out options to build our church.

Our Local Community:

Located 20 miles east of Rochester and 20 miles west of Winona, St. Charles offers big city conveniences with the advantages of small town living. Best known for being the *Gateway to the Whitewater Valley*. St. Charles is a vibrant community of 3,825 people comfortably nestled within the rolling hills and valleys of southeastern Minnesota.

In St. Charles, recreational opportunities abound. The majestic Whitewater State Park is only seven miles north of the city. Saint Charles offers five beautiful city parks offering a variety of activities, including picnic areas, volleyball courts, ball fields, playground equipment and biking and hiking trails.

Neighboring Rochester is known for being culturally diverse, prosperous, and eclectically styled. Rochester offers a variety of can't miss things to do, from attending special events, to getting involved in the arts and learning about local history; to dining at independent restaurants and staying active at area parks.

Church Membership:

We have a membership of approximately 50 members. Our congregation is made up of roughly 40% baby-boomers, 40% Generation X-ers and 20% Millennials. All candidates for membership attend a short membership course explaining church doctrine and principles.

We have a leadership team currently comprised of the Pastor and three elected Elders.

The members of the leadership team are the trustees of the church, and are formally "responsible for the pastoral care of the members, the oversight and direction of ministry, worship, teaching, membership, fellowship, evangelism, finance, premises, all organizations and matters of policy, program and leadership".

- Monthly men's breakfast
- Women's bible study

Areas for Growth

We see the need for our church to be involved with the local community, so that effective evangelism can bring new people to Christ. This will involve growth in personal discipleship and in small group activity.

We feel that God is leading us to research building our own facility which could be a financial challenge. We currently own property and some of the funding has been raised.

The age profile of the church is also rising. We would like to continue to develop programs to reach young families from the community.
